Hi {{.first_name}}, the men’s and women’s college basketball tournament contracts are available for trading, and you can get paid \$1 for predicting the outcome of match-ups in your bracket. Here’s how it works:

- Contract prices change based on trading activity
- If you own a “Yes” position for the winner, each “Yes” contract will pay out \$1
- If you own a “No” position for the loser, each “No” contract will pay out \$1
- If your position is incorrect, you’ll get \$0

Trade your bracket

Make sure you’re on the **latest version** of the app so you can shoot your shot.
